

Tequilas

Tequila Classifications

Blanco (White) - Clear unaged tequila that is bottled after distillation. Also known as Silver, Blancos are the base for all tequilas and are the most direct expression of Agave.

Reposado (Rested) - Aged in Wood at least 60 days. The wood barrels impart a straw color and a mellow, more developed flavor to the tequila. Commonly referred to as Gold Tequilas, Reposados are great in upscale cocktails and are often enjoyed straight up.

Añejo (Aged) - Tequila that is aged at least 1 year in government approved barrels, such as American bourbon casks. Añejos are darker in color than a reposado and have a smoother, more complex flavor. The Tequilas are made for sipping and should be enjoyed as any fine cognac would.
